General Comments - if you have any specific comments you would like to pass on please complete this section.

The road around Fenton are in an even worse state than last year: full of potholes, uneven and poorly maintained. They are now in need of a complete overhaul and resurface. Only repairing the potholes in an adhoc manner is just throwing money down the drain. Signs at both ends of the road from Beckingham to Stubton state "Temporary uneven road surface" How long is temporary as the signs have been there for nearly a year Despite numerous enquiries there is no known plan to properly repair the roads in our Parish. Drainage within the village is poor with an area around the pond that often floods. The problems have been highlighted to the Highways Department but nothing happens. If there are problems on the A17 or A1 traffic, including large articulated lorries, are often diverted through this and neighbouring Parishes on roads that are not in a suitable condition for safe passage. It is a favourite route for cyclists who are at risk because of the state of the surrounding roads.
